



ANTI RAGGING POLICY

Preamble

In view of the directions of the Honorable Supreme Court and in consideration of the rules framed by the central government and the UGC, to prohibit, prevent and eliminate ragging and to provide healthy development to students both physically and psychologically, Shri Sakthikailassh Women's College has set forth the Anti-Ragging Policy.

Ragging is a criminal offense. Ragging is strictly prohibited by both State Government and Central Government Punishment for ragging will be as follows

- Depending upon the nature and gravity of the offence as established by the Anti-Ragging Committee of the institution, the possible punishments for those found guilty of ragging at the institution level shall be any one or any combination of the following
 - a. Cancellation of admission
 - b. Suspension from attending classes
 - c. Withholding/withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits
 - d. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process
 - e. Withholding results
 - f. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - g. A sum of Rupees 25,000 will be levied as fine



Vision

To build a ragging free environment by instilling the principles of democratic values, tolerance, empathy, compassion and sensitivity so that the students become responsible citizens.

Mission

To create an atmosphere of discipline by passing on a clear message that act of ragging is prohibited inside and outside the college premises

Objectives

- To prohibit any conduct by individual student or students in group either spoken or written through words or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling a fresher or any other student with rudeness.
- To create an awareness and the consequences of ragging among all students



- To address any ragging issues immediately and take action as advised by the committee

COMMITTEES AND THEIR FUNCTIONS

The Anti-Ragging Committee

- To monitor the Anti-Ragging activities in the institution
- To consider the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad
- To take appropriate decisions, including spelling out suitable punishments to those found guilty.
- To organize anti ragging awareness programme.

The Anti-Ragging Squad

- To investigate incidents of ragging
- To make recommendations to the Anti-Ragging Committee
- To work under the overall guidance of the Anti-Ragging Committee.
