The college was established in 2004 with the main aim of empowering women through education. With a strong motive that no student is denied the opportunity due to financial inadequacy, scholarships are provided by the institution, Government and non-government bodies and philanthropists. Freeships are given to meritorious students and on need basis. The procedure for grant of freeship by the management is clearly defined in the scholarship policy of the institution.

Scheme of Institutional Scholarship

There are a number of institutional scholarships available to students. These scholarships are made possible through generous donations and fund raising efforts of Om Sri Vivekanandha Educational Trust.

The eligibility and guidelines for availing scholarships are decided by the scholarship committee constituted by the Principal.

Selection procedure of the scholarship

- Scholarship requisition is submitted at the time of admission with the required documents.
- The scholarship committee finalize the student those who are eligible for acquiring the scholarship and submit the list to the management.
- The decision of the management will be final in all matters relating to admission and scholarship.
- Those students who are eligible for the scholarship will pay fee with concession.
- The eligible students for the scholarship will receive the scholarship for their entire course of study.

Conditions for Termination of Scholarship

- The scholarship may be terminated by the management at any given point in time, if it is found that the student has furnished incorrect details/particulars in their application, or is found guilty of malpractice, misconduct, and violation of college policies, rules and regulations
- (i) Merit Scholarship Policy: This scholarships is given to the students based on their performance /mark scored in higher secondary examination. The different fee waiver are given below

(ii) Sports Quota Scholarship Policy

The College offers Sports Scholarship to motivate the students who excel in sports based on their achievement. Those who have secured individual medals/ trophies in State, National International Level competition during their studies, fee concession will be provided after the verification of certificate.

iii) Sivagamiammal Merit Scholarship

This scholarship is provided to those students who are economically backward. The students who apply for this scholarship have to produce a written letter to the management through the principal along with the attached copy of their parent's income certificate.

Based on the income of the parents the management finalise the list of students who are eligible for scholarship and this is approved through trust. The revenue of the applicant's family must be less than **Rs 1,20,000** annually.

iv) Alumni Scholarship

Alumni Association extends a helping hand in supporting the deserving students with an alumni scholarship. The students are selected based on their marks or economic status of parents and feedback from the department. While extending the financial aid it is ensured that the students were not getting other scholarship from multiple agencies or departments. 40% of the alumni contribution is used for scholarship.

Scholarship requisition is submitted at the time of admission with the required documents.

- The scholarship committee finalize the student those who are eligible for acquiring the scholarship and submit the list to the management.
- The decision of the management will be final in all matters relating to admission and scholarship.
- Those students availing scholarship will only pay the remaining fees.
- The selected eligible students are receiving the scholarship for their entire course of study.

(v) Other Concession

- Single Parent Student and Orphans concession based on their Economical status.
- Physically challenged students are given 25% 100% fee waiver.
- Students with AIDS and other physical illness are given 50% 100% Tuition Fee Concession.
- First installment free for UG students graduated from Shri Sakthikailassh Women's College and admitted in PG.
- Fee concession for Faculty Reference upto Rs 5000.
