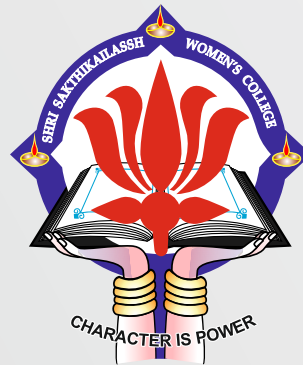

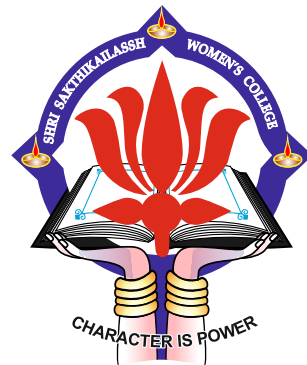

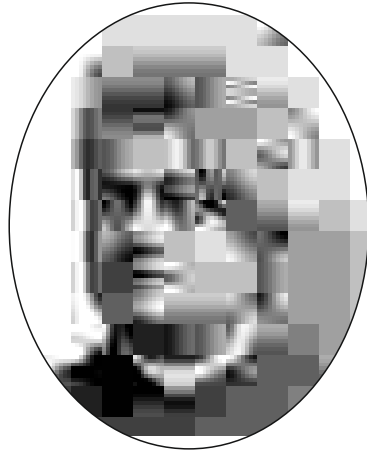

ATTENDANCE AND AVAILING OF LEAVE

Students should attend classes regularly and punctually.

1. Attendance will be taken at the beginning of every lecture period.
2. A student has to score not less than 75% of attendance in the number of working days in a semester to become eligible to appear for the University Exams.
3. A student who absents herself without permission/ leave during any one period of the day will be marked absent for half-a-day.
4. Leave application should be submitted in the prescribed form.
5. In all cases application for leave should be submitted in advance.
6. In unforeseen circumstances, it is to be submitted on the very next day of the concern week.
7. Hostel Students Leave Application must be countersigned by the hostel warden.

IDENTITY CARD

Each student of the college is required to possess an identity card with her passport size photo affixed and attested by the Principal. The ID card will be issued to the student on payment of Rs. 150/-

EXAMINATIONS

1. The progress of the students is assessed by means of Monthly Tests, Mid-Semester, and Model Examinations conducted on the notified dates.
2. It is mandatory that all students should appear for the Tests and Examinations.
3. The absence of the students for Examination without proper reason or leave will be seriously dealt with.
4. Parents will be informed through post about their wards attendance percentage academic progress, and their absence of college.

UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS

COLLEGE LIBRARY

A Library plays a vital role in the search of knowledge. It serves as the workshop for the entire college students and faculty alike. Library of Shri Sakthikailassh Women's College, Salem, Tamil Nadu state aims to support the teaching learning activity in the institution and also supply the student's updated knowledge and to ensure the maximum utilization of the available resources.

The Central library is situated on the first floor of the college main block. It occupies about 7184 sq. ft. and can accommodate about 100 students at a time. The library is provided with proper ventilation, lightning & fan.

Working Hours: 09.00 a. m. - 06.00 p.m. on all working days.

FEES AND PAYMENTS

There are two semesters in a year.

- 1.Student should remit the prescribed fee for each semester within the stipulated time as mentioned in the calendar.
- 2.Fees will be collected from 9.00a.m to 5.00 p. m on all working days.
- 3.Receipts issued for all payments should be kept safe.
- 4.Fees once paid will not be refunded under any circumstance.
- 5.In case of withdrawal (Discontinue) from the college, students should pay the fees for the course duration. (Though the classes have not yet begun).
- 6.University Examination Fee is to be remitted within the time prescribed by the University.
- 7.Hostel fees should be remitted for the full academic year (12 months).
- 8.Hostel facility could be withdrawn only at the end of the semester.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Students should inform their parents well in advance all the details of the various fees to be remitted to the college.

1.All the students must assemble in their respective classrooms by 9.25a.m. The day begins with a common morning prayer. After the prayer the class work begins at 9.30a.m.

2.ID cards must be brought to the college on all working days. It should be shown to any staff member on demand. Possession of ID card is essential till the completion of the course.

3. Important circulars relating to the day-today affair of the college will be on the notice board and the ignorance of any notice will not be accepted as an excuse for failing to comply with it.
4. No meetings of any kind shall be organized in the college without prior permission of the principal & management.
5. Leave or permission to a group or whole class will not be granted on any account for the purposes of religious or social functions.
6. The student should report to the class-in-charge whenever there is a change in her residential address & phone numbers.
7. If any student wants to leave the campus for any reason, academic or non-academic should get prior permission from the HOD and the principal.
8. Students can come to college either by college bus or by using their own vehicles (Two Wheelers). Travailing by auto-rickshaw or Private buses should be avoided.
9. Student should use only the allotted bus and they should board from the permitted place.
10. Students should not reserve seats for the co-students in the bus.
11. Only Parents and Guardians should come to meet the college in person to discuss the student's progress.
12. In the event of violating the rules and regulations of the college, the principal is fully empowered to dismiss the students from the College.
13. No outsiders are permitted to visit students without getting written permission from the College office.
14. Loitering in the verandah and sitting on the staircases are not allowed.

15. Ragging is strictly prohibited. Any student found to be indulging Will in such acts will be dealt with according to provisions of the relevant act.

16. Cell phones, walk man, whistle, radio, binocular, I-pod and camera are not allowed inside the college campus.

17. Students should not interfere in the matters of college administration.

18. Student should abstain from active participation of party and communal politics.

19. Students are expected to keep the classrooms and the College premises neat and tidy. Care must be taken for all college property.

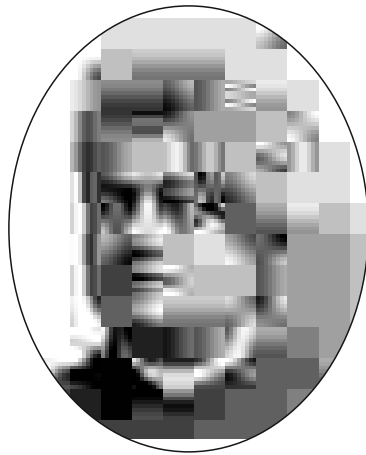
